

The Village at Riverview shareholders break ground on a new assisted living facility.

Cabell County, WV – Known as the Best Little Village in the State, Barboursville, will soon have another choice in retirement living. A group of local investors are breaking ground on a new assisted living facility on Wednesday, October 2nd. Organizers will host the event at the building site. The Village at Riverview is scheduled to open in the spring of 2014, the 33,000 square foot facility will be located at 1356 Riverview Drive. The Community will include 54 private assisted living suites.

Special guests scheduled to attend the groundbreaking ceremony include Governor Earl Ray Tomblin, Mayor Paul Turman, Nancy Cartmill, County Commissioner and representative for West Virginia Assisted Living Association. Additional state and local officials may be in attendance.

“Barboursville is a great community and we are driven to help fill a need for assisted living and housing in the area”, stated Company President, Jeff Gray. Each Assisted Living unit will feature private baths, living space, and an efficiency kitchen. Additionally, the community will offer residents three nutritious meals daily served in a restaurant-style dining room, as well as access to a variety of other common areas including a café/ice cream bar, salon, and sunroom. A spacious and secure outdoor area is designed for gardening and recreation.

The assisted living facility will offer 24-hour care by licensed nursing staff that are trained in geriatric and dementia conditions. Additional support services include housekeeping, laundry, transportation and a diverse activity program.

The company expects to employ approximately 45 people. The facility will be owned and operated by The Village at Riverview of Barboursville, WV. The owners are excited to partner with Mr. Joey Nolasco of Integrity Architecture PLLC, Steven D. Prater Builders, Inc, and BB&T Corporate Banking during the developmental stage.
